



COOKIE AND TRACKING CODE POLICY

This Cookie Policy governs the manner in which TL Safety Limited uses cookies on our Website at www.tlsafety.co.uk ("Site"). By using this Site and agreeing to this policy, you consent to TL Safety Limited's use of cookies in accordance with the terms of this policy.

Web browser cookies

Our Site may use "cookies" to enhance User experience. User's web browser places cookies on their hard drive for record-keeping purposes and sometimes to track information about them. Users may choose to set their web browser to refuse cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If they do so, note that some parts of our Site may not function properly.

Cookies are files sent by web servers to web browsers, and stored by the web browsers. The information is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server. This enables a web server to identify and track web browsers.

There are two main kinds of cookies: session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are deleted from your computer when you close your browser, whereas persistent cookies remain stored on your computer until deleted, or until they reach their expiry date.

Cookies and tracking codes on our website

TL Safety Limited uses the following cookies or tracking codes on our Site, for the following purposes:

- Tracking Web Usage Statistics
- General traffic data
- Saving information in forms

A1 WebStats Tracker and Google Analytics

TL Safety Limited uses A1 WebStats on occasions and Google Analytics to analyse the use of this Site.

This generates statistical and other information about our Site use by means of a tracking code, which is stored on each page of our Site. The information generated relating to our Site is used to create reports about the use of the Site so we are aware of what our Users are accessing on our Site so we can improve User experience.

A1 WebStats and Google Analytics will store and use this information about visitors to our Site to inform TL Safety about the Use of our Site. General traffic data

As part of our website hosting package we receive a report on the number of visitors to our Site each week. This informs us about the number of new visitors and the pages that they view. No personal data about the User is collected during this process.

Saving information on forms

When Users submit personal details through the contact forms on our Site it sends us an email with the contents that you have entered. We use this information only for the purpose of processing data to respond to your request or to provide the services you have requested. The form is not stored on our Site but it is saved on our hosting sever which is secure. We do not request any payment details through our Site and there is no facility to make any card payments or other type of payment through our Site.

Our site is however secure and SSL encrypted and you will see the padlock sign.

Accepting or Refusing Cookies

Most browsers allow you to refuse to accept cookies.

In Internet Explorer, you can refuse all cookies by clicking “Tools”, “Internet Options”, “Privacy”, and selecting “Block all cookies” using the sliding selector.

In Firefox, you can adjust your cookies settings by clicking “Tools”, “Options” and “Privacy”.

Blocking cookies will have a negative impact upon the usability of some websites.
